- ~We collaborated with the Women's Guild in a Candle Project for the deceased of our Parish. It was a great way to build bridges between our two organizations and to get to know one another a little better.
- ~ The ladies pulled off another successful Chili Cook-Off with 12 entrants and cash prizes for the top 3 winners.
- ~Service completed a project serving displaced families, and is now working on a project with the parish for local students.

Spirituality Commission:

- ~Affiliation worked to execute a project that is in alignment with the Eucharistic Revival that is in its second year
- ~ Our ladies are looking into the history of our parish and are planning a fun game to give information to our affiliation. We are also working with Parish Admin to participate in a Feast of St Joseph celebration.
